ESOL REGISTRATION FOR ONLINE CLASSES FALL 2020

The Adult ESOL and Literacy Grant Program at Montgomery College will have morning and evening online ESOL classes in the fall.

Important information

- All fall classes will be offered via Zoom
- If you want a morning class, you must register by **August 23, 2020**. If you want an evening class, you must register by **September 6, 2020**.
- **All new students will take a placement test.** After you register, you will receive information to make a testing appointment.
- If you are a returning student, we will ask for your M#, level, and last teacher's name. If you don't remember some of these, that is okay. Just tell us what you remember.
- Some returning students might need a test. We will tell you if you need a test.
- You can take a regular ESOL class and a Workplace English class. If you want to know more about Workplace English classes, look here:

- You cannot take two ESOL classes or two Workplace English classes. You can only take one of each.
- To register, you must complete this form even if you completed an interest form before.
- You must live in Maryland to take these classes
- You must be at least 18 years old to take these classes
- Students with F1 or J1 visa cannot take classes in this program. Contact ESL-Rockville@montgomerycollege.edu if you have a F1 or J1 and want to take ESOL classes.
